RE Official Information Act request CDHB 10751

I refer to your email dated 8 November 2021 requesting the following information under the Official Information Act from Canterbury DHB. Specifically:

 How many people admitted to emergency department since 1st March until now. As well compared from 1st March 2020 until 31st December 2020. Also breakdown information on reasons for admitting to emergency department.

Between 1 March and 31 December 2020 (10 months) there were 90,147 presentations at Canterbury DHB Emergency Departments and between 1 March and 14 November 2021 (8.5 months) there were 88,447 presentations. **Note** these time periods are not comparable.

Please find attached as **Appendix 1 – Table one** the breakdown of information on reasons for presentations. **Please also note** these are presentations and not individual patients i.e. some people may have presented more than once in the time frame requested.

I trust that this satisfies your interest in this matter.
