RE Official Information Act request CDHB 10723

I refer to your email dated 6 September 2021 to the Ministry of Health which they subsequently partially transferred to us on 22 September 2021 requesting the following information under the Official Information Act from Canterbury DHB. Specifically: Question 1

In an interview for the following article the Health Minister Andrew Little told me that increasing the number of nurses who could help with intensive care would be a focus in the months ahead. Some DHBs hadn't done enough in that area, he said.

"There was extra funding provided last year, and an online module for more nurses to do ICU learning, so that they could go into an ICU environment if they were called for. Some DHBs got on top of it. Others haven't so much."

In regards to the online training mentioned by the Minister, can I please request under the Official Information Act:

1. A breakdown by DHB showing how many nurses had completed the online ICU training module for nurses by August 17, and also now (most up to date figures available).

Staff in this region are able to complete this course through a copy located on the Canterbury DHB Educational Learner Management System, which was made live on the 26 August 2021, or through the Ministry of Health Educational Learner Management System LearnOnline.

Due to privacy restrictions, we are not able to access records directly from the Ministry of Health site.
