I refer to your email dated 16 May 2022 requesting the following information under the Official Information Act from Canterbury DHB. Specifically:

Please note: Where numbers are less than 5 we are declining to provide any further detail pursuant to section 9(2)(a) of the Official Information Act to protect their privacy.

- 1. How many staff are currently employed by Canterbury DHB who are unvaccinated for COVID-19, according to the COVID-19 Public Health Response (Vaccinations) Order?
 - a. How many of these staff are currently working on site at the DHB (i.e. not working from home)?
 - b. How many of these staff are currently working from home?
 - c. How many of these staff are allowed to work because they have a medical exemption for COVID-19?
 - d. How many of these staff are still employed but not allowed to work due to their vaccination status?
