- **COVID-19 virus** MOH website reliable (paper presented)
- Avoid community spread, time to develop a vaccination, hand hygiene
- Avoid anxiety, universal precautions, self isolation (2 metre distance) – body fluid transfer is remote, job lay offs overreaction – more harm
- Free vaccination for vulnerable and Pakeke 65years old+, hapu, child under 5year, multiple co-morbidity e.g. BP, bronchitis, asthma
- Contact tracing for all infectious diseases e.g. utilising medical students. Once confirmed, escalated
- International Initiative for Disability and Mental Health Leaders Conference Ōtautahi, 3-5 March 2021, Te Pae, 500 attending, mobility considerations. Kaupapa - valuing inclusion, resilience and growth.
 - a. ACTION Mihi whakatau invite Tūāhuriri, CDHB, MKWCT korero around earthquake and mosque. Ruru to email information to Kaiawhina to disseminate to MKWCT and update Tumuaki accordingly. Once in a life time opportunity to showcase
- Key messages change kaupapa around mental health, transferring semi-detached to proactivity within communities.
 Support Māori NGO's – continue relations and awhitanga appropriately, collaborative approach utilising Whai Ora.
- Strengthening Māori Providers MKWCT representative on Maui Collective. Support workforce, gain larger contracts to award salary appropriately. Better outcomes for Māori.
- Mental Health dollars Te Pou (Mental Health Foundation) workforce development challenging to access. Little investment and minimal improvement with services.
- MKWCT, Kaupapa Māori, Iwi to influent change Māori

inequities for Māori Executive Director. Wai2575 await Crown to respond. Majority of MOH Vote payments lie with 80% salaries. Drive MOH, Minister and Health Ministry for a Hauora Māori Organisation/separate Māori commissioning agency. Reduce DHB's (3 in Tamaki Makaurau, 2 in Poneke). Issues e.g. management heavy, 16% Māori population nationally, medtech to connect Māori Providers with medical practices.

- Every 5 years practitioners and practices must attend cultural competency treaty training. Gives people knowledge
- Establish relations, collaborate data point of service delivery unraveled, evidence e.g. Māori enrolled however not as referred as much as non-Māori
