Official Information Act (OIA) request ChChD (Canterbury District) 10908

I refer to your email dated 16 June 2022 requesting the following information under the OIA from Waitaha Canterbury. Specifically:

• Do you have versions of the (Tāngata Ora / Our People) survey for each department - with the answers to the main questions and percentages? (If so can I have them).

It has always been the intention to provide Tangata Ora results to our people leaders and staff, however, due to the Covid-19 pandemic and pressures on our system it has not been possible for our Executive and Senior Leaders to review and disseminate all information to our staff. It is important, given the nature of the survey, that staff are the first to hear about our results.

We are currently monitoring the situation with the Covid-19 pandemic and the pressures on our health system with a plan to release the results to staff when appropriate.

After which time, we can provide a copy of relevant reports.

On this basis, we are declining this request under Section 18(d) of the OIA on the basis that the information requested is, or soon will be, publicly available. We anticipate that this will be within the last quarter of the 2022 calendar year, and in December at the latest.
