RE Official information request CDHB 10533

We are writing to acknowledge your email dated 25 January 2021 requesting the following information under the Official Information Act from Canterbury DHB. Specifically:

When the new Waipapa building opened at Christchurch hospital, a release was sent out saying that on Sunday December 12, 359 patients were treated at Christchurch Hospital -- a record number for a single day where a large-scale emergency hadn't occurred.

The influx followed a record-breaking week of patients presenting to the hospital.

Lockdown: The Ministry of Health's data on emergency department attendances in 2020 shows the number of attendances in May 2020 was higher by 200 visits than a year earlier, with roughly 400 more visits in both June and July.

1. Can you provide the number of attendances to the emergency department over May, June and July last year -- and the same data for the year before?
