**RE Official Information Act request CDHB 10612** 

I refer to your email dated 26 May 2021 requesting the following information under the Official Information Act from Canterbury DHB. Specifically:

- 1. How many children aged 0-14 have presented to hospital with a dog-related injury in the last year?
- 2. How many of those children required a procedure (e.g. sutures), or admission?
- 3. What were the ethnic and age demographics of those children?

There were 54 patients aged 0-14 years who presented to Canterbury DHB's Emergency Departments over the last 12 months (June 2020 – May 2021) with dog bites. A third (18) were admitted to hospital from the Emergency Department (ED). (**Note:** this is comparable with previous years).

Please refer to **Table one** (below) for breakdown by demographics.

**Note:** We have aggregated Maori/Pacific/Asian information pursuant to section 9(2)(a) of the Official Information Act *i.e."* ... to protect the privacy of natural persons, including those deceased". (Numbers for Pacific and Asian were <5 each).

We are declining to provide information regarding any other presentations related to 'dogs' as this information is not held in an easily retrievable electronic data system and would require a substantial amount of time and resource to identify. (Declined pursuant to section 18(f) of the Official Information Act.
