- 3. The total / official exact numbers of children between the ages of 5 11 in the Kaikoura District / rohe that have received their first Covid Vaccine shot?
- 4. The total / official exact numbers of children between the ages of 5 11 in the Kaikoura District / rohe that have received their 2nd Covid Vaccine shot?
- 5. The total / official exact numbers of children between the ages of 12 15 in the Kaikoura District / rohe that have received their first Covid Vaccine shot?
- 6. The total / official exact numbers of children between the ages of 12 15 in the Kaikoura District / rohe that have received their 2nd Covid Vaccine shot?

- 10. How many people who have received the vaccine have required medical assistance or/and admitted to hospital for any reason? (We note we received clarification from you on 25 February 2022 that this also relates to people within the Kaikoura District / rohe,)
 - a. within 30 days of receiving the vaccine
 - b. within 60 days of receiving the vaccine
 - c. within 90 days of receiving the vaccine

Please refer to **Table two** (below) for people from the Kaikoura District who were admitted to a Canterbury Hospital <u>for any reason</u> post first vaccination (as at 28 February 2022).
