Parent/Caregiver/Whānau Information - Neonatal Services

Premie Playgroup is run in a relaxed environment and provides an opportunity for babies once they are 2 months past their due date to:

- Spend time with other families/whānau who understand the NICU journey and life with a preterm baby.
- To talk to a physiotherapist about your baby's strengths and challenges.
- Be referred to appropriate services if needed for follow-up, eg. Speech and Language Therapist for feeding concerns.
- Learn how your baby's development may look due to their prematurity.

Premie Play Group is held on the second and forth Monday of the month (school term-time only) from 9.30am-10.30am at The Child Development Service, 440 Montreal Street (Corner of Montreal Street and Bealey Avenue). Parking on site or on Peacock Street.
