**RE Official Information Act request CDHB 10658** 

I refer to your email dated 7 July 2021 requesting the following information under the Official Information Act from Canterbury DHB regarding Covid-19 vaccine rollout. Specifically:

All correspondence between the Canterbury Primary Response Group (CPRG) and CDHB staff in the
past two months (May, June, July to-date), regarding concerns about the speed rolling out the
Covid-19 vaccination programme.

There is no correspondence between CPRG and Canterbury DHB across the time frame May to July 2021 that raises concerns about the speed of rolling out the Vaccination Programme. (Declined pursuant to section 18(e) of the Official Information Act i.e. "...documents containing the information requested do not exist".)

2. The structure of the team within the CDHB responsible for rolling out the vaccine: number of employees involved, name of team, responsibilities.

## **Responsibilities:**

The Programme Office has been set up following the Coordinated Incident Management System (CIMS) structure with key functions in place to coordinate the rollout of the programme. Generic responsibilities for the functions can be found here:

See the organisational diagram (**Appendix 1**) for the high-medium level vaccination programme structure.

Linkages between stakeholder providers such as Canterbury DHB, Primary Health Organisations (PHOs) and community providers are essential. Rather than replicating administration and back-office functions, areas such as Human Resources and Finance; many other services are provided by our stakeholders.

Staff have generally been seconded to the vaccination programme on a full or part-time basis from other roles in the Canterbury health system.

Within vaccination sites there are a number of additional roles to facilitate the effective and efficient delivery of the programme, these include clinical leaders, vaccinators, recovery staff, and administrators.

3. I've been told someone organising the rollout was fired/moved aside due to the slow rollout speed. Please provide details of any action taken by the CDHB to discipline staff involved in the rollout, or actions taken to improve the speed of the rollout.

In respect of your question about whether anyone in the rollout was fired/moved aside or disciplined due to the slow rollout speed, we can confirm that this has not happened. A number of staff changes have occurred during the project which has seen people's roles and responsibilities in the COVID-19 vaccination rollout change due to other work commitments.

 Please provide correspondence between the CDHB and MoH staff in the past two months (May, June, July to-date) regarding concerns about the speed of the Covid vaccination roll-out in Canterbury.

There is no correspondence between Canterbury DHB and the Ministry of Health staff across the time frame May to July 2021 and specifically related to concerns about the speed of rolling out the Vaccination Programme. (Declined pursuant to section 18(e) of the Official Information Act i.e. "... "...documents containing the information requested do not exist".)
