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RE Official information request CDHB 10548

I refer to your email dated 25 February 2021 requesting the following information under the Official Information Act from Canterbury DHB. Specifically:

- During which period was ECT used in gay conversion/aversion therapy at the hospital?
 a. When did the hospital stop the practice?
- 2. How common was this practice?
- 3. Are there any records about the number of patients who received this treatment?
- 4. Why was this used as a treatment?

Canterbury DHB does not hold any information in an easily retrievable electronic system regarding ECT being used in gay conversion/aversion therapy. If the information requested exists it would be in individual historic patient files and would require a substantial, and prohibitive, amount of resource and time to identify.

We are therefore declining your request pursuant to section 18(f) of the Official Information Act i.e. "...the information cannot be made available without substantial collation or research".
